A typical process

- A faculty member at TDU plans to take a group of students abroad
- They submit trip details to the Office of Travel Management (OTM)
- OTM reviews the proposal, makes any necessary adjustments, and creates a dedicated program in TDS to track student enrollment
- Faculty recruits students, forwards roster to OTM, and OTM opens student applications



Program Types

- The program types used for the proposal and enrollment programs will depend on your campus processes
- In our example, we'll use:
 - **Risk Management** program for the proposal
 - **Outgoing with SideTrips and OneStep** for student enrollment



Why?

- **Risk Management** programs allow a custom itinerary *only for the initial application*
- **Outgoing with Side Trips and OneStep** allows registrants to add *additional* travel information to their registration
