What are program types?

- A program's type determines which specific software features are enabled or disabled for that program
- Some program types are preconfigured in the software; others can be downloaded for free from the Terra Dotta Community Library (TDCL)
- The available program types correspond with common use cases for various scenarios



Program Types

- Preinstalled program types:
 - Risk Management
 - Outgoing
 - Incoming
 - Scholarship
- Additional available program types (new in TDS14):
 - Travel Registration
 - Incident Report
 - Outgoing with SideTrips and OneStep
 - Program Enrollment



Program Types

Focus on three types

- Risk Management
 - Allows users to edit their travel plans in the pre-decision phase only
 - Useful for facilitating a travel approval process
- Travel Registration
 - Allows users to edit their travel plans at any time
 - Useful for facilitating self-reported travel registration processes
- Incident Report
 - Disables most process-oriented functions and simply acts as an instantaneous submission of data
