# The Prevalence of Summer Programs

- Campuses host dozens to hundreds of programs every summer attended by minors
- Data about these individuals needs to be centralized for proper querying and reporting



# Point Them in the Right Direction

- Keep your site navigation simple
  - Use your homepage to direct applicants about what they need to do/where they need to go on your site
  - Create links under **Website Admin** that lead to program application pages in one click
    - Access pages for programs are under Settings tab of the program builder
  - Clarify the topics of your programs and who should apply to each using program brochures



# Collecting Important Information

- Direct parents and students using the information section of applications (or the description section of each piece of Learning Content you create)
  - Direct them to print and mail signature documents
  - Note that both students and their parents need to know and sign off on everything regarding their application



# Dealing with Incidents

- Queries can help you track students on-campus much like those done for your travelers off-campus
  - Find pertinent information stored on students like:
    - How they're traveling to your institution
    - Insurance Information
    - Dietary Restrictions
    - Dorm room location



# Sharing Your Information

- Run reports on your programs that can be shared with leaders on campus
