

- The system would use this date and location to search for applicants abroad.



What is a Program Itinerary

- Program itinerary records require a location to be assigned, and they are created to be specific to a registration cycle (term and year).
- When a registrant applies to the program they inherit the program itinerary record.



What is a Registration Itinerary?

 Registration itinerary records do not require a location, and they are created to be specific to a registration.



What do the registrants see?

The registrant will see any registration itinerary records assigned to her/his registrations both on the registrant home page as well as on the registration pages in a panel called 'Itinerary'.
